Community Navigators work 1:1 with individuals and families providing support in accessing and utilizing regional center and generic resources. Navigators have lived experience and share a community, a language, and a culture with people they serve.

This program serves clients of Alta Regional Center from birth to adulthood. (no age limit)

Services provided by WarmLine Navigators include:

- **Parent to Parent Support**
- **Information and Referral to Community Resources**
- **Outreach and Support for Transition Age from Part C**
- **Self-Determination Program information and support**
- **Special Education Information**
- **Support to families whose children are blind/low vision, deaf/hard of hearing, orthopedically impaired**
- **Assistance with generic resources such as Medi-Cal, IHSS & SSI and more.**
