Community Navigators work 1:1 with individuals and families providing support in accessing and utilizing regional center and generic resources.

Navigators have lived experience and share a community, a language, and a culture with people they serve.

This program serves clients of Alta Regional Center from birth to adulthood. (no age limit)

Services provided by WarmLine Navigators include:

- Parent to Parent Support
- Information and Referral to Community Resources
- Outreach and Support for Transition Age from Part C
- Self-Determination Program information and support
- Special Education Information
- Support to families whose children are blind/low vision, deaf/hard of hearing, orthopedically impaired
- Assistance with generic resources such as Medi-Cal, IHSS & SSI and more.
