Gastos de compra de servicios de ACRC y datos demográficos

El centro regional de Alta California (ACRC) presenta los siguientes datos según lo requiere la Ley de Lanterman (Código W e I §4919.5). Estos datos del año fiscal 2017/18 muestra las autorizaciones, gastos y utilizaciones de la compra de servicios (POS) de ACRC, por distintas categorías demográficas según lo resumen las leyes. Además, hay nuevos informes este año que muestran más detalles basados en el lugar de residencia de los consumidores. ACRC les alienta a revisar los datos de gastos y demográficos.

DATOS DE COMPRA DE SERVICIOS DEL CENTRO REGIONAL

Las siguientes páginas proveen información de los datos de la compra de servicios (POS) del Centro regional de Alta California para el año fiscal 2016-2017, según se requiere por la sección 4519.5 del Código de bienestar e instituciones. Alentamos al lector a revisar toda la información incluyendo las primeras páginas que indican algunas limitaciones de los datos.

1. Costos de compra de servicios

Los datos de la compra de servicios (POS) desplegados representan el costo de los servicios que los clientes recibieron que son pagados por el centro regional. Estos datos de gastos de POS no incluyen los costos de servicios que los clientes reciben que son pagaderos por los ingresos de seguridad complementaria, Medi-Cal, el sistema de escuelas y otras agencias genéricas. Los datos de gastos de POS representan gastos incurridos por el centro regional por los servicios que los clientes recibieron en el año fiscal 2017-2018 basados en los datos de reclamos de estados de POS del centro regional, que se proveyeron a Departamento de servicios de desarrollo (DDS) desde el 30 de noviembre, 2018. El centro regional puede incluso todavía realizar pagos por servicios provistos a clientes en el año fiscal 2017-2018 hasta junio de 2020.

2. Conteo de clientes

La cantidad total de clientes que recibieron servicios durante el año fiscal será mayor que la cantidad real de casos del centro regional. Se incluye un cliente en los datos si el cliente recibió un servicio financiado por el centro regional en cualquier momento durante el año fiscal. Se cuenta una sola vez a un cliente que recibió un servicio único en el año de la misma manera que un cliente que recibió servicios mensuales continuos. También se lo cuenta, sin importar su estado actual en el centro regional. Los datos pueden incluir clientes cuyo estado actual sea cerrado, transferido, no activo, etc., si el cliente recibió servicios del centro regional en el año fiscal 2016-2017. Adicionalmente, los datos incluyen clientes que podrían solo haber recibido servicios de gestión de casos.

3. Gastos de compra de servicios por contrato

Debido a las limitaciones del sistema fiscal uniforme del centro regional (UFS), los datos de gastos de POS pueden no incluir pagos hechos por el centro regional que fueron pagados al proveedor de servicios según un "contrato". Actualmente, el UFS no puede asignar gastos pagados a un proveedor de servicios según un "contrato" a clientes que utilicen el servicio de "contratos". Por tanto, los gastos de POS pagados según un "contrato" se excluyen de los datos de POS. Los servicios típicos pagados a un proveedor de servicios según un "contrato" pueden incluir, entre otros, servicios de transporte y los servicios de grupo (SEP) del programa de empleo respaldado. Por tanto, la cantidad total de gastos de POS reportados no serán equivalentes a los gastos reales de POS del centro regional para el año fiscal 2017-2018. Los gastos totales de POS de Alta para el año fiscal 2017-2018 fueron \$363,269,853. Por tanto, este informe no incluye \$48,120,009 de los gastos de contrato.

4. Servicios autorizados

Los servicios que son autorizados sobrecargan los fondos requeridos para pagar esos servicios. El sistema informático del centro regional (UFS) presenta opciones al centro regional sobre la actualización de estas sobrecargas. Cuando se ajustan de forma rutinaria las sobrecargas por la no utilización, habrá un porcentaje más alto de utilización. Cuando no se ajustan de forma rutinaria las sobrecargas por la no utilización, habrá un porcentaje más bajo de utilización.

5. Clientes con diagnósticos múltiples

Hay muchos clientes que tienen más de un diagnóstico. En el informe de resumen Gastos de compra de servicios por diagnóstico y en el informe de Consumidores sin compra de servicios por diagnóstico, estos clientes se contarán en cada categoría para la cual tienen un diagnóstico. Como ejemplo, un cliente con un diagnóstico tanto de autismo como epilepsia se contará tanto en la categoría de autismo como en la de epilepsia. Por tanto, la suma de los clientes registrados en todas las categorías será mayor que el total de clientes servidos por el centro regional.

6. Clientes de categoría 5

Los clientes listados en la categoría 5 según el Código de bienestar e instituciones sección 4512 son personas que tienen "... condiciones que pueden causar una discapacidad que se considera que se relacionan estrechamente con la discapacidad intelectual o requieren tratamientos similares a los requeridos por personas con una discapacidad intelectual, pero no se incluirán otras condiciones que pueden causar discapacidades, cuya naturaleza es únicamente física."

7. Plan de programa individual

Todos los servicios provistos por el centro regional como resultado de un equipo de planificación que incluye al cliente, a miembros de la familia y otros invitados por el cliente y el coordinador de servicios de Alta.

8. Grupo étnico

El Departamento de Servicios de Desarrollo (DDS por sus siglas en inglés) proporcionó los grupos étnicos y estos se basan en grupos previos usados por el DDS para informar de datos demográficos del cliente.

9. Residencia

Se incorporan nuevos datos sobre la residencia de los clientes. En muchos casos, el costo de los servicios para un cliente se ve afectado por el lugar donde reside. Por ejemplo, los clientes que viven en la casa de un padre o tutor generalmente tendrán menores costos que aquellos que no viven con ellos.

10. Copagos, coaseguros y deducibles de seguros

A partir de la aprobación de la Ley del Senado 946, se agregó texto a la sección 4659.1 del Código de bienestar e instituciones, que autorizaba a los centros regionales a pagar cualquier copago o coaseguro aplicable asociado con el servicio o apoyo por los cuales son responsables los padres, tutores o encargados del cuidado. La sección 4519.6 del Código de bienestar e instituciones añadió texto que requiere que los centros regionales reúnan y compilen datos sobre los copagos, coaseguros y deducibles. El centro regional Alta California pagó copagos, coaseguros o deducibles de fondos a 62 clientes en el año fiscal 2017-2018. El número de clientes financiados por copagos y deducibles ha disminuido debido a Medi-Cal que cubre los servicios de tratamiento de salud mental desde febrero de 2017.

11. Idiomas

Los idiomas incluidos en este informe se muestran en detalle en algunas secciones y se agrupan en categorías de resumen en otras secciones. En caso de que se agrupen varios idiomas, se incluye una nota de pie de página para presentar al lector ejemplos de lo que se incorpora en los grupos resumidos.
